With his busy schedule as TV host for prime-time shows at the German TV station RTL, for which he was nominated for the German Television award in 2017, his creative excursions have taken a back seat for some time, only to be rediscovered in 2016 after two awe-inspiring visits to museums in Naoshima and Copenhagen.
