
#### ROAD TO BUDGET 2021



### Passing of Budget 2021


 Restoring Muhyiddin's legitimacy as Prime Minister

### REJECTION OF BUDGET 2021

PM has lost confidence of Parliament

- Two options:
  - Resign; or
  - Seek dissolution of the house

Role of YDPA Agong in appointing PM, election unlikely
