Movement Control	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All EMCO entrances and exits are closed. Control over the local area of infection is carried out by the PDRM with assistance of ATM, APM and RELA. All residents are NOT ALLOWED TO LEAVE their homes / residences. Only one (1) representative from each house is allowed to purchase necessities at the grocery store in the EMCO area within a radius of 10 kilometers from the residence. A maximum of three (3) people only including patients are allowed to go out to get health care, medical and vaccination services Movement across the Area and state for the purpose of COVID-19 vaccination at the Vaccination Center (PPV) outside the Area or state of residence is allowed by showing the appointment details on the MySejahtera application, website or SMS. Any individual who has been subject to a Home Quarantine Order (HSO) is NOT ALLOWED to leave the residence. No unnecessary movement outside the residential area after 8.00 night except for emergency cases or obtaining permission from PDRM. Capacity of one (1) person only per private vehicle (all types). Additional passengers are subject to PDRM approval on a case to case basis. The number of persons allowed in a vehicle carrying goods as well as a chain of economic or industrial activities (excluding the transportation of workers) depends on the vehicle registration license. The number of people allowed in the Department Vehicle or the Official Car of Posting is based on the capacity of the vehicle.

Movement Control		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Land and sea public transport activities and services (train, commuter, LRT, MRT, ERL, Monorail, bus, taxi, ferry, e-hailing) are allowed to operate as usual with a capacity of 50%. The number of passengers in taxis and e-hailing is limited to two (2) people only including the driver. Airports and ports are allowed to operate as usual. Only the essential services sector is allowed to operate from 8.00 am to 8.00 pm. Permission to work only for essential services or to carry out official Government duties with a letter of confirmation from the employer or a valid employee pass. Only employees from necessary services and factories and authorized business premises can use the approval letter of the Ministry or Department that has been issued previously. Employees other than essential services NOT be ALLOWED to leave the EMCO area and may not work during the EMCO period. Employers must comply with this order and allow employees to take leave or work from home. Movements for matters other than those stated in this SOP must obtain permission from the PDRM.

Grocery stores, convenience stores, daily necessities stores are ALLOWED to operate from 8.00 am to 8.00 pm. Supermarkets and hypermarkets are ALLOWED to operate RESTRICTED to the food, beverage and basic necessities section only from 8.00 am to 8.00 pm. Health services such as hospitals, clinics and medical laboratories ALLOWED to operate for up to 24 hours or as per authorization license. Pharmacies, drug stores, animal clinics, pet food stores, ALLOWED to operate from 8.00 am to 8.00 pm. Petrol stations are ALLOWED to operate from 6.00 am to 8.00 pm except petrol stations on toll highways operating for up to 24 hours. The wholesale market is ALLOWED to operate from 12.01 am to 6.00 am. Public Markets, Permanent Farmers Market (PTK) & MyFarm Outlet (MFO) ALLOWED to operate from 6.00 am to 2.00 pm. Daily markets, morning markets, farmers markets, night markets, late night bazaars are NOT ALLOWED to operate. Maintenance, repair and wiring of a critical nature are allowed based on appointment.

<p>Activities within EMCO areas</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> For emergencies such as illness or death, residents are ALLOWED to leave the zone with the approval of PDRM. Consideration can be given by the PDRM and MOH on a case to case basis. Vaccination Centers within the EMCO area are ALLOWED to operate. All educational institutions are CLOSED throughout EMCO. Any sports, social, recreational and cultural activities are NOT PERMITTED. Quarantine centralized training programs implemented by the National Sports Council (MSN) and State Sports Councils (MSN Negeri) are ALLOWED to use the Camp Based Training concept. Quarantine-based training program for teams in the Malaysian Football League (MFL) is ALLOWED to use the SPORTS BUBBLE (Camp Based Training) model. Face -to -face meetings of Government and private agencies are NOT PERMITTED. MOH will conduct targeted screening to all residents involved. Food supply assistance by external parties such as NGOs/ companies/ individuals during the EMCO period to those in need will be determined and distributed by the Area Disaster Management Committee (JPBD) through coordination under the Area/ State Disaster Operations Control Center (PKOB).

The attendance capacity of employees for the civil service in the service should be limited to 20% (excluding frontliners, security and defense personnel). Government counter services are completely closed except: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Health services; Police station; and At international gateways involving customs matters, immigration as well as quarantine. Employee attendance capacity for the private sector in services should include operations and management is limited to 60%.
General Health Protocols	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Licenses and premises owners ensure control of customers' entry and exit to the premises with physical distancing of at least 1 meter. Licenses and premises owners are required to provide the MySejahtera QR Code facility and provide a customer attendance registration book. Hand sanitizer is provided at the entrance and be sure to use it before entry. The use of the MySejahtera application is mandatory in the area of wide internet access. The use of customer attendance registration books is only allowed in areas where there is no internet coverage or other reasonable grounds.
