**Movement Control**


- No inter-state and inter-district crossing (based on the district boundaries set by the State Governments).
- PDRM is responsible for implementing control over local areas of infection with the help of ATM, APM & RELA. The entrances and exits of the MCO areas will be closed and entries controlled by the PDRM.
- Only **two (2)** household representatives are allowed to go out to get food supplies, medicine, dietary supplements and necessities within a radius **not exceeding 10 kilometers** from their residence.
- A maximum of **three (3) persons** only including patients are allowed out for health care, medical, screening, safety or emergency services within a radius **not exceeding 10 kilometers** from their residence or to the nearest place from residence if such health or medical services are not within a **radius of 10 kilometers** from their residence.
- The number of passengers in taxis and e-hailing is limited to **two (2) people** inclusive of driver, passenger must sit in the back.
- The number of persons allowed in a vehicle carrying goods as well as economic or industrial chain of activities (excluding the transportation of workers) depend on the vehicle registration license.
- The number of persons allowed in the Department Vehicle or the Official Position Car is based on the capacity of the vehicle.

Upload time is from 8.00 am to 8.00 pm on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.</li> <li>Unloading activities involving essential goods are not subject to these restrictions and proceed as usual.</li> <li>Sea and land public transport services such as employee transport, stop buses, express buses, LRT, MRT, ERL, Monorail, ferries and other public transport are allowed to operate based on 50% vehicle capacity (operating hours and frequencies subject to the Ministry of Transport) .</li> <li>Movement for cases of death and natural disasters is allowed after obtaining permission from the PDRM.</li> <li>The movement for disaster or humanitarian aid by NGOs is required to obtain permission from the State Disaster Management Committee or District Disaster Management Committee in the area affected by the disaster and the aid is channeled through the Disaster Operations Control Center (PKOB) in the area.</li> <li>Movement across districts and states for the purpose of COVID-19 vaccination at Vaccination Centers (PPVs) outside the district or state of residence is permitted by showing appointment details on the MySejahtera application, website or SMS.</li> <li>Members of Parliament and State Assemblymen are allowed across states and districts to visit their respective areas without performance of any ceremony.</li> <li>Crossing states are <b>allowed</b> for long distance married couples <b>to/fro Phase 2 states with permission from PDRM.</b></li> <li>Movement for Short Term Business Visitors under the approval of the One Stop Center Initiative (OSC) for official or business purposes is allowed after obtaining permission from PDRM.</li> </ul>				



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General Health Protocol	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Licensees and premise owners ensure control of customer entry and exit into premises with physical distancing of at least 1 meter.</li> <li>• Licensees and premise owners are required to provide MySejahtera QR Code facilities and provide customer attendance registration book.</li> <li>• Hand sanitizer is provided at the entrance and ensure of its use before entry.</li> <li>• The use of the MySejahtera application is mandatory in areas with wide internet access. The use of the customer attendance registration book is only allowed at areas without internet coverage or other reasonable grounds (senior citizens, the absence of smartphones etc.).</li> <li>• Licensees and premise owners ensure customers check in the premises using MySejahtera or manually write the name and phone no. in the absence of internet coverage.</li> <li>• It is <b>mandatory</b> for employers, workers, customers and visitors to check in with MySejahtera or to manually write down their names and telephone numbers legibly before entering the premises including at Government, private sector and individual offices.</li> <li>• For shopping malls, supermarkets or department stores, customers need to conduct a body temperature scan only once at the entrance of the complex and not at every business premise under one complex.</li> <li>• Body temperature above 37.5 degrees Celsius is not allowed to enter the complexes and premises.</li> <li>• The owners of the complexes and premises outside the complexes need to ensure only customers with "Low Risk" status including "Casual Contact Low Risk" in MySejahtera is allowed to enter their respective complexes or premises.</li> </ul>

Sports and Leisure

- All individual sports and recreational activities without physical contact for the purpose of health, fitness and self-skills by complying with a physical distancing of at least **2 to 3 meters** and **performed in open areas including semi-open within 10 km from the residence from 6.00 am to 8.00 pm**. Such activities are jogging, exercise, taichi, cycling, skate boarding, fishing, equestrian, archery, climbing, tennis (singles), golf, motoring and etc.
- Operation of all commercial outdoor sports and recreational facilities including partial open with compliance to **50% utilization** capacity/ area. Meanwhile, the operation of outdoor and semi -open public sports and recreation facilities is **SUBJECT** to the Local Governing Authorities (PBT).
- Operation of all sports and recreational facilities **OTHER THAN** outdoor and semi -open is **RESTRICTED** for essential management purposes (finance, maintenance and such) only with compliance not exceeding **30% of workforce capacity**.
- Organizing tournaments or competitions via quarantined and closed **WITHOUT** the presence of spectators/ supporters according to the Sports Bubble Model is **RESTRICTED** to those organized by the Ministry of Youth and Sports (KBS), Malaysian Football League and Petronas Cup Prix Championship only.
- Quarantine centralized training program implemented by the National Sports Council (NSC) and State Sports Councils (State NSCs) using the Camp Based Training concept.
- Centralized training program including quarantine training matches for teams in the Malaysian Football League (MFL) using the **Camp Based Training** (Model Gelembung Sukan).
- Participation of Malaysian athletes/ coaches/ officials/ technicians to tournaments or competitions or matches abroad **SUBJECT** to the **approval** of the Malaysian Immigration Department (JIM) **WITH** KBS/ MSN support.
