- 3. Building construction works that provide complete accommodation for workers on construction sites or workers housed in Centralized Workers Quarters (CLQ)

WORKING CAPACITY

- 1. Working capacity allowed **60%**

Phase 2

ACTIVITIES PERMITTED AS IN PHASE 1 AND EXTENDED TO:

- 1. Construction works that place workers in CLQ
- 2. Renovation works for individual residential houses/commercial buildings

3. Export of Continental Shelf Sea Sand on a case by case basis
4. The operation of mines and quarries is based on the requirements set by CIDB

MOVEMENT CONTROL (MAIN)



Phase 1

MAIN MOVEMENTS:

1. Crossing state and county borders is NOT ALLOWED
2. Only two (2) representatives to get daily necessities (radius 10 km from the residence)
3. Only three (3) people to get health, safety or emergency services (radius 10 km from the residence/place closest to the residence)
4. Crossing states for long distance husband and wife not allowed

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Phase 2

MAIN MOVEMENTS:

1. Maintained as in Phase 1 **except for the movement of students and school teachers for examination classes**
2. Maintained as in Phase 1
3. Maintained as in Phase 1
4. Cross -state for long -distance husbands and wives is allowed for **emergencies and special needs with the approval of PDRM**



Phase 3

MAIN MOVEMENTS:

1. Cross -county is **allowed**. Cross -state remains **unauthorized**.
2. **Only three (3)** representatives to get daily necessities and **no limit of 10 km from residence**
3. **Only three (3)** people to get **health, safety or emergency services and no limit of 10km from the residence**
4. Long distance cross -country for husband and wife is allowed with the **approval of PDRM**

Phase 4

MAIN MOVEMENT

1. Crossing state and county borders is **allowed** based on set conditions
2. Allowed out of the house **according to vehicle capacity**

MOVEMENT CONTROL (PUBLIC TRANSPORT)



Phase 1

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION:

1. Limited to **Two (2) people** including taxi driver and e-hailing
2. Ports and airports are **allowed** to operate
3. Sea and land public transport services (limited to 50% of vehicle capacity with **frequencies subject to MOT**)

- 3. The number of people in the Department Vehicle or Official Position Car is based on the capacity of the vehicle
- 4. Members of Parliament and State Assemblymen are allowed across states and districts to visit their respective constituencies.

1. Allowed face to face with 50% of space capacity and Current SOP

1. In -service training can be implemented according to the new norms.

BUSINESS ACTIVITIES

1. Restaurants, eateries, food stalls, food trucks, roadside hawkers, street hawkers, food courts, hawker centers, roadside food stalls or kiosks **are allowed to operate on a takeaway, drive -by or delivery basis**

4. The wholesale market is allowed to operate from the hour **12.01 am to 6.00 am and 11.00 am to 4.00 pm**

UNAUTHORIZED ACTIVITIES

1. Night markets, farmers markets, morning markets, Sunday markets and guest markets **are not allowed to operate.**

EDUCATION



Phase 1

1. All schools and institutions education including IPTA and IPTS are **closed**.
2. All face -to -face Teaching and Learning (PdP) activities **are not allowed** and must be continued **online**.
3. Students who are in dormitories are **allowed** to remain in dormitories, universities or educational institutions.
4. Pupils of international schools and expatriate schools involved in international examinations are **allowed** to attend to sit for their examinations.
5. International examinations and professional bodies as well as research activities that require laboratory facilities in HLIs are **allowed**.

Phase 2

1. Maintained as in Phase 1 with the following additions:
 - i. Schools are open to conduct face-to-face (PdP) **limited** to examination classes.
 - ii. Subject to the stipulations of the MOE and MOHE Calendar together with the current risk assessment.

For students that need to cross state boundaries from Peninsular Malaysia to Sabah and Sarawak or vice versa, they must comply with the quarantine rules currently in force.

Phase 3

Opening of schools, public and private Higher Learning Institutes, vocational schools and other educational institutions under KPM, KPKT and KPLB as well as other agencies are subject to the KPM and KPT Calendar together with the current risk assessment.

KINDERGARTENS, NURSERIES AND RESIDENTIAL CARE HOMES

1. Prayer activities are limited to a maximum of 12 mosque and surau committee members only. Other activities are **not allowed**.

WEDDINGS

1. Islamic wedding ceremonies (marriage contracts) are allowed only in the Office Islamic Religious Department with attendance in accordance with the ruling of the State Religious Authority.

FUNERALS

1. The management of the burial of the remains of Muslims is **allowed** in accordance with the ruling of the State Religious Authority

RELIGIOUS ACTIVITIES

1. Prayer activities are **allowed but limited to 50% of the capacity of the surau/mosque whichever is the lowest and subject to the ruling of the State Religious Authority**. Other activities are **not allowed**.

1. Islamic wedding ceremonies (akad nikah) are **allowed** only in the Office/Islamic Religious Department and mosque/surau with attendance in accordance with the ruling of the State Religious Authority.

FUNERALS

1. Maintained as in Phase 1.

RELIGIOUS ACTIVITIES

1. Islamic religious activities such as Friday prayers, congregational prayers and other activities such as knowledge gatherings in mosques/surau are **allowed according to the size of the mosque/surau space with physical imprisonment and according to the ruling of the State Religious Authority**.

WEDDINGS

1. Islamic wedding ceremonies (akad nikah) are **allowed only in Islamic Religious Offices/ Departments and suraus/mosques subject to a limit of 50% of the capacity of the premises and physical distancing** as well as in accordance with the rulings of the State Religious Authority.

FUNERALS

1. Maintained as in Phase 1

RELIGIOUS ACTIVITIES, WEDDINGS AND FUNERALS (OTHER THAN ISLAM)

1. House of Worship activities other than Islam (RISI) is **limited to a maximum of 12 members** of the house of worship committee only and the presence of other believers are **not allowed**.

WEDDINGS

1. Marriage ceremonies at the National Registration Department (JPN), Houses of Worship and Religious Associations are limited to 10 people including the Registrar of Marriage and subject to the size of the space available and physical distancing.

1. RISI activities are **allowed according to the size of the House of Worship with physical distancing and subject to the ruling by the IGP**.

Phase 4

FORMAL AND INFORMAL EVENTS

1. Formal and Informal events are **allowed** subject to a limit of **50% of the capacity of the premises and physical distancing**.

SOCIAL EVENTS

1. Social events such as feasts, festive celebrations, weddings, receptions, aqiqah, prayers, tahlil, birthday celebrations, reunions, retreats and other social gatherings are **allowed** subject to a **50% capacity limit of the premises and physical distancing**.

GUESTS AND VISITORS

1. Receiving guests or visitors at the residence is allowed subject to a limit of 50% of the capacity of the premises and physical distancing.

SPORTS, LEISURE AND RECREATION (ACTIVITIES)



Phase 1

1. Individually permitted sports and recreational activities in open areas without physical contact **RESTRICTED to jogging and exercise only** while complying with a physical distancing of at least 2 - 3 meters.
2. Can only be done in **neighbourhood areas**.
3. Sports and recreational activities carried out in groups or involving physical contact is **not permitted**.
4. Activity time starts at **7.00am to 8.00 pm**

Phase 2

1. All individual sports and recreational activities **must not be in physical contact** for the purpose of health, fitness and self-skills by adhering to physical distancing of at least **2 to 3 meters**.
2. Activities should be done in **OPEN areas ONLY** and within 10 km of the residence.
3. Individual activities such as jogging, exercise, taichi, cycling, skate boarding, fishing, equestrian, archery, climbing, tennis (singles), golf, motoring and the like.
4. The time allowed for such activities are between 6.00 am to 8.00 pm.

Phase 3

1. All individual sports and recreational activities **must not be in physical contact** for the purpose of health, fitness and self-skills and must adhere to physical distancing of at least **2 to 3 meters**
2. Activities can be performed in **open areas (outdoors) or indoors SUBJECT** to the movement control instructions in force
3. Individual activities such as jogging, exercise, taichi, cycling, skate boarding, fishing, equestrian, archery, climbing, tennis (singles), golf, motoring, swimming, jet skiing, badminton (singles), bowling, gym activities and the like
4. Individual activities performed in small groups are **SUBJECT** to the designated capacity (operation) or not exceeding 50 people (**SUBJECT** to area/ use and suitability). Examples: aerobics, zumba and the like.
5. The time allowed to perform the activity is from **6.00 am to 10.00 pm**.

Phase 4

1. All sports and recreational activities are allowed
2. Activities can be performed in **open areas (outdoor) or indoor (indoor) SUBJECT** to the movement control instructions in force.
3. Activities involving mass gatherings are allowed with **RESTRICTED** participation according to the capacity of the area or not exceeding 500 people (whichever is lower) at any one time
4. There is no time limit set for performing activities.

SPORTS, LEISURE & RECREATION (FACILITY OPERATION)



Phase 1

1. The operation of all sports and recreational facilities is not permitted **EXCEPT** parks - public parks **SUBJECT** to local authorities.

Phase 2

1. Operation of open public sports and outdoor recreation facilities **SUBJECT** to the Local Authority (PBT).
2. Operation of commercial sports and recreational facilities in open areas **WITH** supervisory control. Use by reservation **ONLY** (walk-ins are not allowed).
3. Operating hours are from **6.00 am to 8.00 pm**.
4. The operation of open-air sports and recreation facilities is **SUBJECT** to the utilization capacity by complying with physical distancing of at least 2-3 meters.
5. Operation of all indoor sports and recreation facilities and swimming pools is not permitted **EXCEPT** for necessary management purposes (finance and maintenance) only.

Phase 3

1. Operation of outdoor and indoor public sports and recreation facilities including swimming pools **SUBJECT** to the Local Authority (PBT).
2. Operation of **COMMERCIAL** sports and recreational facilities in outdoor and indoor areas including swimming pools **WITH** supervisory control. Use by reservation **ONLY** (walk-ins are not allowed).
3. Operating hours are from **6.00 am to 10.00 pm**
4. The operation of outdoor sports and recreation facilities is **SUBJECT** to the utilization capacity by complying with physical distancing of at least 2-3 meters.
5. The operation of indoor sports and recreational facilities and swimming pools is **SUBJECT** to 50% of area capacity/use.

Phase 4

1. Operation of **ALL** sports and recreational facilities is permitted
2. Operating time is **SUBJECT** to local authority and license conditions
3. Usage capacity/area **optimally**.

1. Organization of closed tournaments or competitions in quarantine according to the sports bubble model organized by the National Sports Council (NSC) and only.
