Permitted Activities
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> One (1) representative from each home to buy necessities. Essential services.
Prohibited Activities
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Leaving the home for activities other than those permitted without PDRM permission. Exiting the area by residents. Entry of others into an EMCO area.
Standing Orders
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Subsection 11(3) of Act 342. Subject to conditions issued by the NSC and MOH. Other orders issued from time to time by the Authorized Officer under Act 342.

Measure	Brief Description
Movement Control	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All EMCO entry and exits are closed. Control over local areas of infection is carried out by the Royal Malaysian Police (PDRM) with the assistance of the Malaysian Armed Forces (ATM), Malaysia Civil Defence Force (APM) and the People's Volunteer Corps (RELA). All residents are NOT ALLOWED TO LEAVE their respective homes / residence. Only one (1) representative from each home is allowed to buy necessities at grocery stores within the EMCO area in a radius of 10 kilometers from their residence. A maximum of three (3) people only including the driver is allowed to exit to obtain healthcare services, medication and vaccination. Inter-district and inter-state movement for the purpose of COVID-19 vaccination in Vaccination Centres (<i>Pusat Pemberian Vaksin [PPV]</i>) in a district or state outside their residential area is allowed by showing appointment details through the MySejahtera app, online or SMS. Any individual subjected to a Home Quarantine Order (HSO) IS NOT ALLOWED to leave the residence. No non-essential movement outside residential areas after 8:00 pm except for emergency cases or by obtaining permission from PDRM. Capacity of one (1) person only per private vehicle (all types). Additional passengers are subject to permission from PDRM on a case-to-case basis. The number of people allowed in a vehicle carrying foods as well as the economic activity or industry supply chain (except for the transportation of workers) is dependent on the commercial vehicle registration license. The number of people allowed in a Department Vehicle or an Official Post Car is based on the capacity of the vehicle.

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Movement Control	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Public land and sea transportation services (trains, commuters, LRT, MRT, ERL, monorail, buses, taxis, ferries and e-hailing) are allowed to operate as usual with a 50% capacity. The number of passengers in taxis and e-hailing is limited to two (2) people only including the driver. Airports and ports are allowed to operate as usual. Movements to carry out official Government duties is allowed with a confirmation letter from the Head of Department or a valid employee pass subject to current instructions from the Chief Secretary to the Government. Movement for legal-related purposes are based on the letter issued by MITI (CIMS). Permission to work for the private sector is only for the essential services with an employer confirmation letter or valid employee pass. Only workers in the essential services and factories as well as business premises which are permitted can use the previously issued Ministry or Department approval letter. Employees other than those in the essential services ARE NOT ALLOWED to exit the EMCO area and cannot work throughout the EMCO period. Employers must comply with this order and allow employees to take leave or work from home. For the manufacturing and service sectors, the Ministry or Department approval letter previously issued only applies for those stated in the List of Essential Services (A. Manufacturing Sectors, B. Service Sectors and C. Agriculture, Fisheries, Livestock and Plantation). Whereas Ministry or Department approval letters for non-stated sectors are not applicable during this EMCO period. Movement for matters other than those specified in this SOP must obtain permission from PDRM.

Measure	Brief Description
Activities in EMCO areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Restaurants, food shops/stalls, food trucks, roadside hawkers, mobile hawkers, food courts/hawker centers, roadside food stalls/kiosks are ALLOWED to operate from 8:00am to 8:00pm. The purchase of food is only ALLOWED by take away, drive-thru or delivery. Dine-in and <i>park & dine services</i> are NOT ALLOWED. Grocery stores, convenience stores, daily necessity stores are ALLOWED to operate between 8:00am to 8:00pm. Supermarkets and hypermarkets are ALLOWED to operate LIMITED to the food, beverage and basic necessity sections only from 8:00am to 8:00pm. Healthcare services such as hospitals, clinics, and medical laboratories are ALLOWED to operate for up to 24 hours or in accordance with their operational license. Pharmacies, drugstores, veterinarians, animal feed stores, are ALLOWED to operate from 8:00am to 8:00pm. Petrol stations are ALLOWED to operate from 6:00am to 8:00pm except for petrol stations on highways which can operate 24 hours. Wholesale markets are ALLOWED to operate from 12:01am to 6:00am. Public markets, Permanent Farmers Markets (<i>Pasar Tani Kekal – PTK</i>) and MyFarm Outlets (MFO) are ALLOWED to operate from 6:00am to 2:00pm. Day markets, morning markets, farmer markets, night markets and late night bazaars are NOT ALLOWED to operate. Critical maintenance, repair and wiring is allowed based on appointments.

Activities in EMCO areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> For emergencies such as illness or death, residents are allowed to exit the zone with approval of PDRM. Consideration may be given by PDRM and MOH on a case-to-case basis. Vaccination Centers in EMCO areas are ALLOWED to operate. All education institutions are CLOSED during the EMCO. All sports, social, recreational and cultural activities are NOT ALLOWED. Centralized training programs with quarantine organized by the National Sports Council (MSN) and State Sports Councils (State MSNs) are ALLOWED using the Camp Based Training concept. Centralized training programs with quarantine for teams in the Malaysian Football League (MFL) are ALLOWED using the SPORTS BUBBLE model (Camp Based Training). Government agency and private sector face-to-face meetings are NOT ALLOWED. MOH will conduct targeted screening on all affected residents. Food supply assistance by external parties such as NGOs/companies/individuals during the EMCO period to those in need will be determined and distributed by the District Disaster Management Committee (JPBD) through coordination under the District/State Disaster Operations Control Center (PKOB).

Religion	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Islamic religious activities are subject to State Religious Authority rulings. Non-Islamic religious activities are subject to the Ministry of National Unity rulings.
Childcare Centers, <i>Tabikas</i>, nurseries and Daycare Centers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>Tabikas</i>, childcare centers, private kindergartens, kindergartens in private, international and expatriate schools as well as mind development centers for children between the ages of 4 and 6 are NOT ALLOWED TO OPERATE EXCEPT for children whose parents and guardians are both frontliners and working in essential services. Residential care centers or rehabilitation centers for children, People with Disabilities, senior citizens, women and multi-purpose care centers are allowed to operate in accordance with the SOPs prescribed under the relevant Ministry, Department or Agency. Parents or guardians sending their children to childcare centers are ALLOWED to use vehicles with child passengers according to the vehicle capacity.

Permission to Operate & Movement of the Civil Service and Private Sector	<p>Only the Essential Services:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The operation of Government Offices for involved EMCO areas are subject to orders by the Chief Secretary to the Government in relation to the operations of Government Offices in the effective Phase 1 Movement Control Order period. The attendance capacity of workers for the civil service in the essential services is limited to 20% (not including frontliners, security and defence personnel). Government service counters are fully closed except: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Healthcare services; Police stations; and International gateways involving customs, immigration and quarantine matters. The attendance capacity of workers for the private sector in essential services including operations and management is limited to 60%.
General Health Protocol	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The license holder and premise owner to ensure control on the entry and exit movement of customers on the premises with at least 1 meter physical distancing. It is mandatory for the license holder and premise owner to provide a MySejahtera QR code and a customer attendance registration book. Hand sanitizers are to be provided at entrances and to ensure its use before entry. Use of the MySejahtera app is mandatory in areas with extensive internet access. Use of the customer attendance registration book is only allowed for areas without internet access or for other reasonable reasons. The license holder and premise owner to ensure customers and workers check-in to the premises using MySejahtera or to manually write down their name and telephone number if there is no internet access.

LIST OF ESSENTIAL SERVICES

A. Manufacturing Sectors

List of Main Food and Beverage Manufacturing*

- Sugar, cooking oil, flour, rice, bread, dairy products, grains, milk powder, cookies, sardines, instant noodles, condensed and evaporated milk, salt, *bihun*, noodles, soy sauce, sauces, spices, baby food, frozen food (chicken, beef, mutton, seafood, vegetables) as well as pet food.

List of Beverage Manufacturing*

- Mineral water, chocolate malt, coffee, tea and fresh milk.

List Of Hygiene, Health, Hygiene and Personal Care Manufacturing*

- Medicine, medical equipment and devices, medical laboratory testing, baby diapers, adult diapers, medicine, hand sanitizers and face masks.

Aerospace List*

- Components and Maintenance, Repairs and Overhaul (MRO)

Machinery And Equipment List*

- Only in relation to the production of health and food products

Electrical And Electronics Manufacturing List*

- Including the supply chain

*Only involving the packaging, labelling and transportation supply chain

LIST OF ESSENTIAL SERVICES

- B. Service Sectors**
- Water, electricity and energy.
 - Health.
 - Banking and capital markets.
 - Veterinary and animal feed requirements.
 - Security and safety, defence, emergency, welfare and humanitarian aid.
 - Transportation by land, water or air.
 - Port, shipyard and airport services and operations, including unloading, *laiter* transport, cargo handling and piloting, and storage or bulk commodities.
 - Hotels and accommodation (only for the purpose of quarantine, segregation, employees in the essential services and not for tourism).
 - Communications including media, telecommunications and the internet, post and courier as well as broadcasting (for the purpose of delivering information, news and the like only).
 - Sanitation, solid waste management and sewerage.
 - Information technology and e-commerce (for ordering and delivery purposes only).
 - Food, beverage and parcel delivery services or p-hailing.
 - Legal practice (subject to the Legal Services EMCO SOP by the Legal Affairs Department)
 - Production, distillation, storage, supply and distribution of fuels and lubricants

*Any activity that is part of the supply chain to the Service Sector list only.

- Agriculture, fisheries and livestock as well as its supply chain
- Plantation (palm oil only) and its supply chain

LIST OF PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES (NEGATIVE LIST)	
Economic Activities	Economic sectors other than those listed in A. Manufacturing Sectors, B. Service Sectors and C. Agriculture, Fisheries, Livestock and Plantation in the List of Essential Services.
Entertainment Activities	NOT ALLOWED.
Sports and Recreation Activities	NOT ALLOWED. Public parks will be closed.
Tourist Activities	All outbound and inbound tourist activities, and within the EMCO areas are NOT ALLOWED.
Social Activities & Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All official/non-official Government/Private Sector functions, or any form of social function is NOT ALLOWED. Any form of seminar, course, training, class or any educational activity/face-to-face learning is NOT ALLOWED.
