All building owners are required to provide a QR Code on each level. 7. Citizens and Non -Citizens Returning/Arriving from Abroad	 Citizen and non -citizen travelers who have a residence in Malaysia (including PR and Malaysia MY Second Home) who return or arrive from abroad and have been fully vaccinated, are allowed to undergo mandatory quarantine at home and are given a digital Home Surveillance and Observation Order (HSO) subject to the details issued by the Ministry of Health Malaysia (MOH). Demonstrate evidence of a valid negative RT PCR test report and conducted 3 days before departure. Have a complete COVID-19 vaccination validity certificate (depending on the type of vaccine). No symptoms during the health screening at the National International Gateway. Have a suitable residence to carry out quarantine. Individuals who return / arrive from abroad and have not been fully vaccinated or not vaccinated must undergo quarantine at a designated quarantine center and subject to the details issued by the Ministry of Health Malaysia (MOH). The mandatory quarantine period for travelers from all countries is 14 days and can be extended for another 7 days if there is a need based on the results of the risk assessment conducted on the 14th day. For travelers from India, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, Nepal and Pakistan, the quarantine period is 21 days or as stipulated by the MOH.
