General Health Protocol | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Licensees and premises owners are required to provide the MySejahtera QR Code facility and provide a customer attendance registration book. • Hand sanitizer is provided at the entrance and its use is ensured before entering. The use of the MySejahtera application is mandatory in the area of wide internet access. The use of customer attendance registration books is only allowed in areas where there is no internet coverage or other reasonable reasons (senior citizens, absence of smartphones etc.). • The licensee and the owner of the premises ensure that customers check in the premises using MySejahtera or manually write the name and no. phone if there is no internet coverage. • Employers, employees, customers and visitors are required to check in MySejahtera or write manually the name and phone number that can be read (if there is no internet coverage) before entering the premises, including in Government offices, private and private. • For shopping malls, supermarkets or department stores, customers only need to perform a body temperature scan once at the entrance of the complex and not at every business premises under one complex • Body temperatures above 37.5 degrees Celsius are not allowed to enter the complex and premises. • The owners of complexes and premises outside the complex must ensure that only customers with "Low Risk" status including "Casual Contact Low Risk" in MySejahtera are allowed to enter their respective complexes or premises. • Licensees and premises owners ensure control of customer entry and exit to the premises with a physical confinement of at least 1 meter. |
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4. General Health Protocol	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individuals 17 years of age and under are not encouraged to be in place and public facilities. • Licensees and premises owners limit the number of customers being on the premises with physical confinement of at least 1 meter at a time. • Each premise must display the total number of customer entry limits at any one time. The use of a queue number system is encouraged for customers entering from a premise. • All building owners are required to provide a QR Code on each level. • Employees, suppliers and customers are required to wear face masks properly according to the MOH's recommendations while on the premises. • Ensure good VENTILATION SYSTEM in the premises based on the guidelines for ventilation and indoor air quality issued by the Department of Occupational Safety and Health (DOSH). • It is compulsory to wear a face mask, especially when in crowded public places except for the following activities and places <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Hotel rooms or accommodation pay alone and involve members of the household. b) Solitary work space. c) Sports and recreational activities. d) Own vehicle and involve household members. e) Indoor or outdoor public areas and places without any other individuals. f) When eating and drinking in a public place without any other individual (other than in restaurants or food premises).

Citizens and Non -Citizens Returning/ Arriving from Abroad	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Citizen and non -citizen travelers who have a residence in Malaysia (including PR and Malaysia MY Second Home) who return or arrive from abroad and have been fully vaccinated, are allowed to undergo mandatory quarantine at home and are given a digital Home Surveillance and Observation Order (HSO) subject to the details issued by the Ministry of Health Malaysia (MOH). • Demonstrate evidence of a valid negative RT PCR test report and run for 3 days before departure. • Have a complete COVID-19 vaccination validity certificate (depending on the type of vaccine). • No symptoms during the health screening was done at the National International Gateway. • Have a suitable residence to carry out quarantine
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individuals who return / arrive from abroad and have not been fully vaccinated or not vaccinated must undergo quarantine at a designated quarantine center and subject to the details issued by the Ministry of Health Malaysia (MOH). • The mandatory quarantine period for travelers from all countries is 14 days and can be extended for another 7 days if there is a need based on the results of the risk assessment conducted on the 14th day. • Travelers are required to make a daily self -assessment through the Home Assessment Tool (HAT) in the MySejahtera app and this activity should continue until the end of the quarantine period (either 14 days or 21 days from the date of arrival). • Travelers are required to undergo COVID-19 infection detection test screening COVID-19 RT-PCR test upon arrival at PMA. A repeat screening test of the COVID-19, RT-PCR COVID-19 infection detection test was performed on the 10th or 18th day (for travelers who had to undergo quarantine for 21 days).

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9. RTK Antigen testing on employees is carried out every 2 weeks at the cost borne by the employer.

Movement Control | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cross -districts within the same state are allowed. • Cross -state (based on district boundaries set by the State Government) is not allowed except for long -distance couples, long -distance children and individuals whose movement has been approved by the MOH and PDRM. • PDRM is responsible for implementing control over local areas of infection with the help of ATM, APM & RELA. The entrance and exit of the VAT area is closed and entry is controlled by the PDRM. • Movement for individuals who have been fully vaccinated is allowed based on the total capacity of the vehicle. Individuals are allowed to bring children 17 years of age and under in compliance with general health protocols. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ Only three (3) household representatives are allowed out only to get food supplies, medicine, dietary supplements and basic necessities. ➢ A maximum of three (3) people only including patients are allowed out to seek health care services, medical, screening tests, vaccination programs, safety or emergency. • The number of passengers in taxis and e-hailing is limited to three (3) people only inclusive driver, passenger must sit in the back. • The number of passengers allowed in a vehicle carrying goods as well as the chain of economic or industrial activities including the transportation of workers depends on the vehicle registration license. • The number of people allowed in the Department Vehicle or the Official Car of the Post is based on the capacity of the vehicle. • Activities and services at all airports and ports are allowed to operate • 24 hours. |
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11. Movement Control	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sea and land public transport services such as stop buses, express buses, ferries and other public transport are allowed to operate based on the full capacity of the vehicle. Unloading activities at premises, factories and ports are permitted. Movement for cases of death and natural disasters is allowed after obtaining permission from the PDRM The movement of disaster or humanitarian aid by NGOs needs to obtain permission from the State Disaster Management Committee or District Disaster Management Committee in the area affected by the disaster and the aid is channeled through the Disaster Operations Control Center (PKOB) in the area. Movement across districts and states for the purpose of COVID-19 vaccination at Vaccination Centers (PPVs) outside the district or state of residence is permitted by showing appointment details on the MySejahtera application, website or SMS. Members of Parliament and State Assemblymen are allowed across districts and states to visit their respective constituencies. Movement for Short Term Business Visitors under the approval of the One Stop Center Initiative (OSC) for official or business purposes is allowed after obtaining permission from PDRM. Cross-state for long-distance married couples who have not received a complete vaccine is allowed between Phase 3 and Phase 2 states with the permission of PDRM and submit: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Copy of husband and wife's identity card ➤ Copy of marriage certificate/ card ➤ Copy of proof of residence of husband/ wife or employer's confirmation letter.
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12. Public Service	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Subject to the current direction of the Secretary of State. • The operation of Government offices is implemented in a hybrid manner through being in the office and Working From Home (BDR) using the following approaches: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ Office attendance does not exceed 80% for the whole (excluding frontliners, security, defense and enforcement services) and 20% BDR by rotation. ➢ Counter services are open subject to the current instructions of the Secretary General of the Country. • Attendance to the office must be accompanied by official instruction documents and employee pass.
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13. Private Service	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All essential services sectors approved by the relevant Ministry or Agency may operate during the NRP period subject to the approval letter of the relevant Ministry. The movement of employees is subject to registration or operating approval letter or employee pass or employer confirmation letter • Employee attendance capacity for the private sector in services should include operations and management limited to 80%.
