- Licensees and premises owners limit the number of customers being on the premises with physical distancing of at least 1 meter at a time.
  - Each premise must display the total number of customer entry limits at any one time. The use of a queue number system is encouraged for customers entering from a premise.
  - All building owners are required to provide a QR Code on each level.
  - Employees, suppliers and customers are required to wear face masks properly according to the MOH's recommendations while on the premises.
  - Ensure good VENTILATION AND VENTILATION SYSTEM in the premises based on the guidelines for ventilation and indoor air quality issued by the Department of Occupational Safety and Health (DOSH).
  - It is mandatory to wear a face mask, especially when in a crowded public place
  - except for the following activities and places:
    - a) Hotel rooms or accommodation pay alone and involve members of the household.
    - b) Solitary work space.
    - c) Sports and recreational activities.
    - d) Own vehicle and involve household members.
    - e) Indoor or outdoor public areas and places without any other individuals.
    - f) When eating and drinking in public places without any other individuals (other than in restaurants or food premises).

- PDRM is responsible for implementing control over local areas of infection with the help of ATM, APM & RELA. The entrance and exit of the VAT area is closed and entry is controlled by the PDRM.
- Movement for individuals who have been fully vaccinated is allowed based on the total capacity of the vehicle.
- Meanwhile, for those who have not received a complete vaccine:
  - > Only two (2) household representatives are allowed out just to get
  - food supplies, medicines, dietary supplements and basic necessities.
  - A maximum of three (3) people only including patients are allowed out to seek health care services, medical, screening tests, vaccination programs, safety or emergency.
- The number of passengers in taxis and e-hailing is limited to two (2) people only including the driver, passengers must sit in the back.
- · The number of people allowed in the vehicle carrying goods as well as the chain of activities
- economy or industry (except employee transportation) depends on the vehicle registration license.
- The number of people allowed in the Department Vehicle or the Official Car of the Post is based on the capacity of the vehicle.
- Activities and services at all airports and ports are allowed to operate 24 hours.

- Unloading activities involve non -essential goods in factories factories are limited to the Movement delivery and receipt of goods or cargo in the existing stockpile for the purpose of import and export only with a limited number of employees.
  - Unloading activities involving essential items are not subject to these restrictions and proceed as usual.
  - Sea and land public transport services such as employee transport, stop buses, express buses, LRT, MRT, ERL, Monorail, ferries and other public transport are allowed to operate based on 50% vehicle capacity (operating hours and frequencies subject to the Ministry of Transport).
  - Movement for cases of death and natural disasters is allowed after obtaining permission from the PDRM.
  - The movement of disaster or humanitarian aid by NGOs needs to obtain permission from the State Disaster Management Committee or District Disaster Management Committee in the area affected by the disaster and the aid is channeled through the Disaster Operations Control Center (PKOB) in the area.
  - Movement across districts and states for the purpose of COVID-19 vaccination at Vaccination Centers (PPVs) outside the district or state of residence is permitted by showing appointment details on the MySejahtera application, website or SMS.
  - Members of Parliament and State Assemblymen are allowed across districts and states to visit their respective constituencies without performing any ceremony.
  - Movement for Short Term Business Visitors under the approval of the One Stop Center Initiative (OSC) for official or business purposes is allowed after obtaining permission from PDRM.
