Complete Vaccination	<p>Individuals who have been fully vaccinated are individuals who have met the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> For vaccine types that require two doses of injection (such as Cormirnaty (Pfizer-BioNTech), COVID-19 AstraZeneca (Oxford-AstraZeneca), CoronaVac (Sinovac), Spikevax (Moderna) and Covilo (Sinopharm)), the individual must have passed the th day. -14 from the date of injection of the second dose; or For types of vaccines that require only one injection dose (such as COVID-19 Janssen (Johnson & Johnson) and Convidecia (CanSino), the individual must have passed the 28th day from the date of injection.

Citizens and Non - Citizens Returning/ Arriving from Abroad</p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Citizen and non -citizen travelers who have a residence in Malaysia (including PR and Malaysia MY Second Home) who return or arrive from abroad and have been fully vaccinated, are allowed to undergo quarantine at home and are given a digital Home Surveillance and Observation Order (HSO) subject to the risk assessment of the Ministry of Health Malaysia (MOH) and details issued by the MOH. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Show evidence of RT PCR test report with negative result conducted 3the day before departure. ➤ Have a valid certificate of vaccination COVID-19 complete dose (depending on the type of vaccine). ➤ There were no symptoms during the health screening at the National International Gateway (PMA). ➤ Have a suitable residence to carry out quarantine. Individuals who return / arrive from abroad and have not been fully vaccinated or not vaccinated must undergo quarantine at a designated quarantine center and subject to the details issued by the Ministry of Health Malaysia (MOH). The mandatory quarantine period for travelers from all countries is 14 days and can be extended for another 7 days if there is a need based on the results of the risk assessment conducted on the 14th day. Travelers are required to make a self -assessment every day through the Home Assessment Tool (HAT) in the MySejahtera application and this activity must continue until the endquarantine period (either 14 days or 21 days from the date of arrival). Travelers are required to undergo the COVID-19 infection detection test screening i.e. the COVID-19 RT-PCR test upon arrival at PMA. A repeat screening test of the COVID-19, RT-PCR COVID-19 infection detection test was performed on the 10th or 18th day (for travelers who had to undergo quarantine for 21 days).

5. General Health Protocol		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Licensees and premises owners are required to provide the QR Code facility MySejahtera and provide customer attendance registration book. Hand sanitizer is provided at the entrance and its use is ensured before entering. The use of the MySejahtera application is mandatory in the area of wide internet access. The use of customer attendance registration books is only allowed in areas where there is no internet coverage or other reasonable reasons (senior citizens, absence of smartphones etc.). The licensee and the owner of the premises ensure that customers check in the premises using MySejahtera or manually write the name and no. phone if there is no internet coverage. Employers, employees, customers and visitors are required to check in MySejahtera or write manually the name and phone number that can be read (if there is no internet coverage) before entering the premises, including in Government offices, private and private. For shopping malls, supermarkets or department stores, customers only need to perform a body temperature scan once at the entrance of the complex and not at every business premises under one complex. Body temperatures above 37.5 degrees Celsius are not allowed to enter the complex and premises. The owners of complexes and premises outside the complex must ensure that only customers with "Low Risk" status including "Casual Contact Low Risk" in MySejahtera are allowed to enter their respective complexes or premises. Licensees and premises owners ensure control of customers' entry and exit to the premises with physical imprisonment of at least 1 meter.

5. General Health Protocol		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Individuals 17 years of age and under are not encouraged to be in public places and facilities. Licenses and premises owners limit the number of customers on the premises with physical imprisonment of at least 1 meter at a time. Each premise must display the total number of customer entry limits at any one time. The use of a queue number system is encouraged for customers entering from a premise. All building owners are required to provide a QR Code on each level. Employees, suppliers and customers are required to wear face masks properly according to the MOH's recommendation while on the premises. Ensure good VENTILATION AND VENTILATION SYSTEM in the premises based on the guidelines for ventilation and indoor air quality issued by the Department of Occupational Safety and Health (DOSH). It is mandatory to wear a face mask, especially when in a crowded public place except for the following activities and places: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Hotel rooms or accommodation pay alone and involve members of the household. b) Solitary work space. c) Sports and recreational activities. d) Own vehicle and involve household members. e) Indoor or outdoor public areas and places without any other individuals. f) When eating and drinking in public places without any other individuals (other than in restaurants or food premises).

6. Control Movement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cross -state is allowed between Phase 4 states only. State -to -state Phase 1, Phase 2 and Phase 3 are allowed with permission PDRM and submit relevant documents. The movement of workers across the state to Phase 1, Phase 2 and Phase 3 is subject to registration or operating approval letter or employee pass or employer confirmation letter. Cross-state movement for the purpose of COVID-19 vaccination at Vaccination Centers (PPVs) outside the district or state of residence is permitted by showing appointment details on the MySejahtera application, website or SMS. Members of Parliament and State Assemblymen are allowed across the state to visit their respective areas. Individual movement, transportation of goods and public transportation of all types of vehicles are allowed based on the total capacity of the vehicle and vehicle registration license. Activities and services at all airports and ports are allowed operates 24 hours.

Organizations are like triathlon, open swim, marathon, trail run, obstacle run, cycling etc. Attendance of spectators/ supporters to sports and recreation venues SUBJECT to 50% area/ seating capacity or 10,000 people (whichever is lower).The participation of Malaysian athletes/ coaches/ officials/ technicians to tournaments or competitions or matches abroad is SUBJECT to the approval of the Malaysian Immigration Department (JIM) WITH the support of KBS/ MSN. Admission of foreign athletes/ coaches/ officers/ technicians to Malaysia is SUBJECT to approval Malaysian Immigration Department (JIM) WITH the support of KBS/ MSN and compliance with regulations on the entry of foreigners into Malaysia.
