

General Health Protocol	• It is mandatory for the license holder and premise owner to provide a MySejahtera QR code and a customer attendance registration book.
	 Hand sanitizers are to be provided at entrances and to ensure its use before entry.
	• Use of the MySejahtera app is mandatory in areas with extensive internet access. Use of the customer attendance registration book is only allowed for areas without internet access or for other reasonable reasons (senior citizens, no smartphone and others).
	 The license holder and premise owner to ensure customers check-in to the premises using MySejahtera or to manually write down their name and telephone number if there is no internet access.
	• It is mandatory for employers, workers, customers and visitors to check in with MySejahtera or to manually write down their name and telephone number legibly before entering the premises including at Government, private sector and individual offices.
	 For shopping centres, supermarkets or departmental stores, customers only need to scan their body temperature once at the entrance to the complex and not at every business premise within one complex.
	 A person with a body temperature of above 37.5 degree Celsius is not allowed to enter the complex and premises.
	 The owner of the complex and premises outside the complex must ensure that only customers with the status "Low Risk" including "Casual Contact Low Risk" in the MySejahtera app are allowed inside their respective complex / premises.
	 The license holder and premise owner to ensure control on the entry and exit movement of customers on the premises with at least 1 meter physical distancing.

Showing evidence of a negative RT-PCR test report that is valid and conducted 3 days before departure. Having a valid and complete COVID-19 vaccination certificate (dependent on the type of vaccine). No symptoms during the health screening conducted at Malaysia's International Arrival Gate. Having a suitable residence to carry out quarantine.
	 Individuals returning / arriving from abroad who have not been fully vaccinated or vaccinated at all must undergo quarantine at a designated quarantine centre subject to further details issued by the Ministry of Health (MOH).
	 The mandatory quarantine period for travellers from all countries is 14 days and can be extended for another 7 days if required based on the risk assessment result conducted on the 14th day
	 Travellers are required to conduct a daily self-assessment through the Home Assessment Tool (in the MySejahtera application and this assessment must be continued until the end the quarantine period which is either 14 days or 21 days from the date of arrival.
	 Travellers are required to undergo a RT PCR COVID 19 detection test upon arrival at PMA. Repeat of the RT PCR COVID 19 detection test must be conducted on day 10, or day 18 for travellers who have to
