Areas Involved	<p><b>FEDERAL TERRITORY OF LABUAN, NEGERI SEMBILAN AND PAHANG</b></p> <p><b>*This SOP must be read together with the Special SOP of the Federal Territory of Labuan.</b></p> <p><b>** For areas enforced by EMCO, EMCO SOP in the area is effective until the expiry date of the EMCO.</b></p>				
2. Effective Period	<p><b>*For the Federal Territory of Labuan starting on 26 August 2021 (from 12.01 am)</b></p> <p><b>** For Negeri Sembilan starting on 24 September 2021 (starting 12.01 am).</b></p> <p><b>*** For Pahang State starting on 8 October 2021 (starting 12.01 am).</b></p>				
3. Complete Vaccination	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Individuals who have been fully vaccinated are individuals who have met the following criteria:           <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For vaccine types that require two doses of injection (such as Cormirnaty (Pfizer-BioNTech), COVID-19 AstraZeneca (Oxford-AstraZeneca), CoronaVac (Sinovac), Spikevax (Moderna) and Covilo (Sinopharm)), the individual must have passed the th day. -14 from the date of injection of the second dose; or</li> <li>For types of vaccines that require only one injection dose (such as COVID-19 Janssen (Johnson &amp; Johnson) and Convidecia (CanSino), the individual must have passed the 28th day from the date of injection.</li> </ol> </li> <li><b>For individuals who cannot be vaccinated for health reasons, they need to submit a medical report that has been certified by a registered medical practitioner.</b></li> </ul>				



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4. Citizens and Non - Citizens Returning/ Arriving from Abroad	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Citizen and non -citizen travelers who have a residence in Malaysia (including PR and Malaysia MY Second Home) who return or arrive from abroad and have been fully vaccinated, are <b>allowed</b> to undergo quarantine at home and are given a digital Home Surveillance and Observation Order (HSO) subject to the <b>risk assessment</b> of the Ministry of Health Malaysia (MOH) and details issued by the MOH. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Show evidence of RT PCR test report with negative result conducted 3the day before departure.</li> <li>Have a valid certificate of vaccination COVID-19 complete dose (depending on the type of vaccine).</li> <li>There were no symptoms during the health screening at the National International Gateway (PMA).</li> <li>Have a suitable residence to carry out quarantine.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Individuals who return / arrive from abroad and have not been fully vaccinated or not vaccinated must undergo quarantine at a designated quarantine center and subject to the details issued by the Ministry of Health Malaysia (MOH).</li> <li>The mandatory quarantine period for travelers from all countries is 14 days and can be extended for another 7 days if there is a need based on the results of the risk assessment conducted on the 14th day.</li> <li>Travelers are required to make a self -assessment every day through the Home Assessment Tool (HAT) in the MySejahtera application and this activity must continue until the endquarantine period (either 14 days or 21 days from the date of arrival).</li> <li>Travelers are required to undergo the COVID-19 infection detection test screening i.e. the COVID-19 RT-PCR test upon arrival at PMA. A repeat screening test of the COVID-19, RT-PCR COVID-19 infection detection test was performed on the 10th or 18th day (for travelers who had to undergo quarantine for 21 days).</li> </ul>

5. General Health Protocol	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Licensees and premises owners <b>are required</b> to provide the QR Code facility MySejahtera and provide customer attendance registration book.</li> <li>Hand sanitizer is provided at the entrance and its use is ensured before entering.</li> <li>The use of the MySejahtera application <b>is mandatory</b> in the area of wide internet access. The use of customer attendance registration books is only allowed in areas where there is no internet coverage or other reasonable reasons (senior citizens, absence of smartphones etc.).</li> <li>The licensee and the owner of the premises ensure that customers check in the premises using MySejahtera or manually write the name and no. phone if there is no internet coverage.</li> <li>Employers, employees, customers and visitors <b>are required</b> to check in MySejahtera or write manually the name and phone number that can be read (if there is no internet coverage) before entering the premises, including in Government offices, private and private.</li> <li>For shopping malls, supermarkets or department stores, customers only need to perform a body temperature scan once at the entrance of the complex and not at every business premises under one complex.</li> <li>Body temperatures above 37.5 degrees Celsius <b>are not allowed</b> to enter the complex and premises.</li> <li>The owners of complexes and premises outside the complex must ensure that only customers with "Low Risk" status including "Casual Contact Low Risk" in MySejahtera are allowed to enter their respective complexes or premises.</li> <li>Licensees and premises owners ensure control of customers' entry and exit to the premises with physical distancing of at least 1 meter.</li> </ul>				



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5. General Health Protocol	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Individuals 18 years of age and under</b> are <b>not encouraged</b> to be in public places and facilities.</li> <li>Licenses and premises owners limit the number of customers on the premises with physical distancing of at least 1 meter at a time.</li> <li>Each premise must display the total number of customer entry limits at any one time. The use of a queue number system is encouraged for customers entering from a premise.</li> <li>All building owners are required to provide a QR Code on each level.</li> <li>Employees, suppliers and customers <b>are required</b> to wear face masks properly according to the MOH's recommendation while on the premises.</li> <li>Ensure good <b>VENTILATION AND VENTILATION SYSTEM</b> in the premises based on the guidelines for ventilation and indoor air quality issued by the Department of Occupational Safety and Health (DOSH).</li> <li><b>It is mandatory</b> to wear a face mask, especially when in a crowded public place <b>except</b> for the following activities and places:               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hotel rooms or accommodation pay alone and involve members of the household.</li> <li>Solitary work space.</li> <li>Sports and recreational activities.</li> <li>Own vehicle and involve household members.</li> <li>Indoor or outdoor public areas and places without any other individuals.</li> <li>When eating and drinking in public places without any other individuals (other than in restaurants or food premises).</li> </ol> </li> </ul>				



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6. Control Movement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cross-state is allowed for individuals who have fully received the vaccine by presenting the COVID-19 Vaccination Digital Card/ Certificate and identity card/ passport as proof. State -to -state Phase 1, Phase 2 and Phase 3 are allowed with permission PDRM and submit relevant documents.</li> <li>For individuals who have received a complete vaccination are allowed to bring children aged 18 years and under in adherence to general health protocols.</li> <li>Permission for cross -state movement is not allowed in areas or localities declared by the Enhanced Movement Control Order (EMCO).</li> <li>The movement of workers across the state is subject to an employee pass or letter confirmation from the employer.</li> <li>Individual movement, transportation of goods and public transportation of all types of vehicles are allowed based on the total capacity of the vehicle and vehicle registration license.</li> <li>Activities and services at all airports and ports <b>are allowed</b> operates 24 hours.</li> </ul>				



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7. Public and Private Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>100% attendance capacity.</li> <li>The Civil Service is subject to the current direction of the Secretary of State.</li> </ul>				
8. Meetings and Interviews	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Face -to -face meetings and interviews are allowed for individuals who have fully received the vaccine subject to space capacity with physical distancing.</li> <li>Individuals who have not been vaccinated must undergo a pre-event test using a self-test kit (saliva) before attending witnessed by the organizer or confirmation from a medical practitioner or attend a meeting by video conference.</li> <li>Meetings are encouraged to be conducted by video conference.</li> </ul>				
9. Seminars, Workshops, Courses, Training and Talks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Seminars, workshops, courses, trainings and talks are allowed for individuals who have completed receiving the vaccine subject to space capacity with physical distancing.</li> <li>Individuals who have not been vaccinated must undergo a pre-event test using a self-test kit (saliva) before attending witnessed by the organizer or confirmation from a medical practitioner.</li> </ul>				
10. Government and Private Official Councils	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Government and private official councils are allowed for individuals who have fully received the vaccine subject to space capacity with physical distancing.</li> <li>Individuals who have not been vaccinated must undergo a pre-event test using a self-test kit (saliva) before attending witnessed by the organizer or confirmation from a medical practitioner.</li> </ul>				



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11. Social Activities		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Social ceremonies such as feasts, festive celebrations, wedding or engagement celebrations, wedding ceremonies, receptions, aqiqah ceremonies, prayers, tahlil, birthday celebrations, birthday celebrations, reunions, retreats and other social ceremonies are allowed for individuals who have fully received the vaccine with 50% space capacity and physical distancing.</li> <li>For individuals who have received a complete vaccination are allowed to bring children 18 years of age and under in compliance with general health protocols.</li> </ul>			
12. Agriculture, Fisheries, Livestock, Plantation, Commodities and Logging		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All activities and chains are allowed to operate in accordance with the conditions of the license except as stated in the List of Unauthorized Activities (Negative List).</li> </ul>			
13. Manufacturing, Construction, Mining and Quarrying Sectors		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For the manufacturing, construction, mining and quarrying sectors that achieve complete vaccination rates for workers as follows:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) 80% to 100%: Allowed to operate with 100% employee capacity.</li> <li>(b) Less than 80%: Allowed to operate with a capacity of up to 80% employees only.</li> <li>(c) RTK Antigen testing on employees is carried out every 2 weeks at the cost borne by the employer.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>			



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14. Trade and Distribution Sector	<p><b><u>Provided the Customer has been Completely Vaccinated</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Photography store and photography services</li> <li>Second hand store</li> <li>Florist and nursery</li> <li>Handicraft and souvenir shop</li> <li>Antique shop</li> <li>Toy store</li> <li>Carpet store</li> <li>Creative content store and creative industry equipment</li> <li>Outdoor equipment store (including camping, fishing equipment, etc.)</li> <li>Cosmetics, skincare and perfume stores</li> <li>Tobacco stores (including vape and electronic cigarettes)</li> <li>Home goods and kitchen equipment store</li> <li>Furniture store</li> <li>Sports equipment store</li> <li>Vehicle accessories store</li> <li>Vehicle distribution and sales center</li> <li>Clothing, fashion and accessories store</li> <li>Jewelry store</li> <li>Barber shop</li> <li>Beauty center/ salon</li> <li>Housing Gallery (Show Room)</li> </ol> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Premises owners must ensure that customers wishing to enter the premises MUST show a COVID-19 Digital Vaccination Card/ Certificate proving that the customer has been fully vaccinated.</li> <li>For parents/ guardians who have received a complete vaccination are allowed to bring children aged 18 years and below to the premises in accordance with general health protocols.</li> </ul>				






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<p><b>15. Dine-in</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Restaurant operators including hotels, sports and recreation club houses, eateries, food stalls, catering vehicles, roadside hawkers, street hawkers, food courts, hawker centers, roadside food stalls and kiosks are allowed to provide dining-in services subject to the following conditions:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Only accept clients who have been fully vaccinated and asymptomatic.</li> <li>➤ Business premises owners MUST display a fully vaccinated and asymptomatic customer acceptance notice only at the entrance of the premises.</li> <li>➤ Employees who have received a complete dose of vaccine and are asymptomatic only allowed to work.</li> <li>➤ The owner of the business premises must ensure that the table layout according to the plan and the premises have a good ventilation system.</li> <li>➤ Dine-in activities with physical distancing of at least 1 meter are subject to SOP KPDNHEP VAT Phase 4-Distribution Trade.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Individuals who have received a complete vaccination are allowed to bring children aged 18 and under for dine-in at the premises in compliance with general health protocols.</li> </ul>				



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16. Market	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All types of markets except night markets and week markets are allowed to operate according to licenses or permits subject to the local authority (PBT) with compliance with SOPs and supervision of RELA or PBT members.</li> <li>The wholesale market is allowed to operate according to the operating hours set by the license and permit conditions of the Local Authority (PBT) provided that the employees are fully vaccinated and comply with the SOP with the supervision of RELA or PBT members.</li> <li>Night markets and week markets are allowed to operate by ensuring customers that want to enter the night market and week market area MUST show a Digital Card/ Certificate</li> <li>COVID-19 vaccination which proves the customer has been fully vaccinated.</li> </ul>				
17. Spa, Wellness Center and Wellness Massage	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Business operations of spas, wellness centers and health massages are allowed to fully vaccinated visitors and operators.</li> <li>Employees and customers must have a complete vaccine, not a COVID-19 positive case, not close contact to a positive and asymptomatic case.</li> <li>Only allow customers who have an appointment. Walk-ins are not allowed.</li> <li>Wear gloves (disposable type), face mask, and face shield during activities.</li> <li>Replace (including gloves, bed linen or mattress or chair) and mite cleaning equipment including face shield) for each customer.</li> <li>Ensure the ventilation system is maintained according to schedule.</li> <li>Monitoring by MOTAC will also be conducted including:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>SPA operators need to declare the number of employees have been fully vaccinated and submitted</li> <li>at MOTAC before being allowed to operate.</li> <li>Self -Compliance Program SOP especially ventilation in the premises.</li> <li>Spot check and periodic monitoring inspections are conducted by MOTAC.</li> <li>COVID-19 detection test screening on symptomatic workers.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
