- i. For types of vaccines that require two doses of injection such as Cormirnaty (Pfizer BioNTech COVID19 AstraZeneca (Oxford AstraZeneca), CoronaVac (Sinovac) Spikevax (Moderna) and Covilo (Sinopharm), the individuals must have passed the 14th day from the date of the second dose injection; or
- For types of vaccines that require only one injection dose such as COVID 19 Janssen ii. (JohnsonJohnson) and Convidecia (CanSino), the individuals in question must have passed the 28th day of date of injection.
- For individuals who cannot be vaccinated for health reasons, they will need to submit a report medicine certified by a registered medical practitioner.
