For types of vaccines that require two doses of injection such as Cormirnaty (Pfizer BioNTech COVID19 AstraZeneca (Oxford AstraZeneca), CoronaVac (Sinovac) Spikevax (Moderna) and Covilo (Sinopharm), the individuals must have passed the 14th day from the date of the second dose injection; or ii. For types of vaccines that require only one injection dose such as COVID 19 Janssen (JohnsonJohnson) and Convidecia (CanSino), the individuals in question must have passed the 28th day of date of injection. Citizens and Non - Citizens Returning/ Arriving from Abroad	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Citizen and non -citizen travelers who have a residence in Malaysia (including PR and Malaysia MY Second Home) who return or arrive from abroad and have been fully vaccinated, are allowed to undergo mandatory quarantine at home and are given a digital Home Surveillance and Observation Order (HSO) subject to the risk assessment of the Ministry of Health Malaysia (MOH) and details issued by the MOH. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Shows evidence of RT PCR test report with negative result conducted 3 days before departure. ➤ Have a valid certificate of vaccination COVID-19 complete dose (depending on the type of vaccine). ➤ No symptoms during health screening at the National International Gateway (PMA). ➤ Have a suitable residence to carry out quarantine. Individuals who return / arrive from abroad and have not been fully vaccinated or not vaccinated must undergo quarantine at the designated quarantine center and subject to the details issued by the Ministry of Health Malaysia (MOH). The mandatory quarantine period for travelers from abroad is 7 days at home (if applicable) or a quarantine station for travelers with complete vaccination. While the mandatory quarantine period of 10 days at the quarantine station for travelers who are not fully vaccinated. Travelers are required to make a daily self -assessment through the Home Assessment Tool (HAT) in the MySejahtera app and this activity should continue until the end of the quarantine period (either 7 days or 10 days from the date of arrival). Travelers are required to undergo the COVID-19 infection detection test screening i.e. the COVID-19 RT-PCR test upon arrival at PMA.

7. Public Health Protocol	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Licensees and premises owners are required to provide the MySejahtera QR Code facility and provide a customer attendance registration book. Hand sanitizer is provided at the entrance and its use is ensured before entering. The use of the MySejahtera application is mandatory in the area of wide internet access. The use of customer attendance registration books is only allowed in areas where there is no internet coverage or other reasonable reasons (senior citizens, absence of smartphones etc.). The licensee and the owner of the premises ensure that customers check in the premises using MySejahtera or manually write the name and no. phone if there is no internet coverage. Employers, employees, customers and visitors are required to check in MySejahtera or write manually readable names and telephone numbers (if there is no internet coverage) before entering the premises including in Government, private and private offices. For shopping malls, supermarkets or department stores, customers only need to perform a body temperature scan once at the entrance of the complex and not at every business premises under one complex. Body temperatures above 37.5 degrees Celsius are not allowed to enter the complex and premise. The owners of complexes and premises outside the complex must ensure that only customers with “Low Risk” status including “Casual Contact Low Risk” in MySejahtera or COVID-19 Vaccination Card are allowed to enter their respective complexes or premises. Licensees and premises owners ensure control of customer entry and exit to the premises with a physical distancing of at least 1 meter.
