1. Area Involved	<p><b>SARAWAK AND KELANTAN.</b></p> <p><b>*For Sarawak, please refer to the National Recovery Plan - SOP Phase 3 Sarawak.</b></p> <p><b>** For areas enforced by EMCO, the EMCO SOP in the area is effective until the expiry date of the EMCO.</b></p>				
2. Effective Period	<p><b>Starting on 16 August 2021 (starting 12.01am).</b></p> <p><b>*For Kelantan, starting on 18 October 2021 (starting 12.01 am).</b></p>				
3. Complete Vaccination	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Individuals who have been fully vaccinated are individuals who have met the following criteria:                             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For vaccine types that require two doses of injection (such as Comirnaty (Pfizer-BioNTech), COVID-19 AstraZeneca (Oxford-AstraZeneca), CoronaVac (Sinovac), Spikevax (Moderna) and Covilo (Sinopharm)), the individual must have passed the 14th day from the date of injection of the second dose; or</li> <li>For vaccine types that require only one dose of injection (such as COVID-19 Janssen (Johnson &amp; Johnson) and Convidecia (CanSino)), the individual must have passed the 28th day from the date of injection.</li> </ol> </li> <li>For individuals who cannot be vaccinated for health reasons, they need to submit a medical report that has been certified by a registered medical practitioner.</li> </ul>				



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4. Public Health Protocol	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Licensees and premises owners are required to provide the MySejahtera QR Code facility and provide a customer attendance registration book.</li> <li>Hand sanitizer is provided at the entrance and its use is ensured before entering.</li> <li>The use of the MySejahtera application is mandatory in the area of wide internet access. The use of customer attendance registration books is only allowed in areas where there is no internet coverage or other reasonable reasons (senior citizens, absence of smartphones etc.).</li> <li>The licensee and the owner of the premises ensure that customers check in the premises using MySejahtera or manually write the name and no. phone if there is no internet coverage.</li> <li>Employers, employees, customers and visitors are required to check in MySejahtera or write manually the name and phone number that can be read (if there is no internet coverage) before entering the premises, including in Government offices, private and private.</li> <li>For shopping malls, supermarkets or department stores, customers only need to perform a body temperature scan once at the entrance of the complex and not at every business premises under one complex.</li> <li>Body temperatures above 37.5 degrees Celsius are not allowed to enter the complex and premises.</li> <li>The owners of complexes and premises outside the complex must ensure that only customers with “Low Risk” status including “Casual Contact Low Risk” in MySejahtera or COVID-19 Vaccination Card are allowed to enter their respective complexes or premises.</li> <li>Licensees and premises owners ensure control of customer entry and exit to the premises with a physical distancing of at least 1 meter.</li> </ul>

States Crossing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>States crossing is allowed for fully vaccinated individuals by presenting the COVID-19 Vaccination Digital Card/ Certificate and identity card/ passport as proof.</li> <li>Fully vaccinated individuals are allowed to bring children aged 18 and under in accordance with general health protocols.</li> <li><b>It is recommended to undergo the COVID-19 test when performing activities in line with the National COVID-19 Testing Strategy guidelines</b></li> </ul>				



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6. Citizens and Non -Citizens Returning/ Arriving from Abroad	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Citizen and non -citizen travelers who have a residence in Malaysia (including PR and Malaysia MY Second Home) who return or arrive from abroad and have been fully vaccinated, are allowed to undergo mandatory quarantine at home and are given a digital Home Surveillance and Observation Order (HSO) subject to the risk assessment of the Ministry of Health Malaysia (MOH) and details issued by the MOH.               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Show evidence of RT PCR test report with negative result conducted 3 days before departure.</li> <li>Have a valid certificate of vaccination COVID-19 complete dose (depending on the type of vaccine).</li> <li>There were no symptoms during the health screening at the National International Gateway (PMA).</li> <li>Have a suitable residence to carry out quarantine.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Individuals who return / arrive from abroad and have not been fully vaccinated or not vaccinated must undergo quarantine at a designated quarantine center and subject to the details issued by the Ministry of Health Malaysia (MOH).</li> <li>The mandatory quarantine period for travelers from abroad is 7 days at home (if applicable) or a quarantine station for travelers with complete vaccination. While the mandatory quarantine period of 10 days at the quarantine station for travelers who are not fully vaccinated.</li> <li>Travelers are required to make a daily self -assessment through the Home Assessment Tool (HAT) in the MySejahtera app and this activity should continue until the end of the quarantine period (either 7 days or 10 days from the date of arrival).</li> <li>Travelers are required to undergo a COVID-19 infection detection test screening viz COVID-19 RT-PCR test upon arrival at PMA.</li> </ul>

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9. <i>Dine-in</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Restaurant operators including hotels, sports and recreation club houses, eateries, food stalls, catering vehicles, roadside hawkers, circulating hawkers, food courts, hawker centers, roadside food stalls and kiosks are allowed to provide dine-in services subject to the following conditions:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Only accept clients who have been fully vaccinated and asymptomatic</li> <li>➤ The owner of the business premises <b>MUST</b> display the customer acceptance notice that has been completely vaccinated and asymptomatic only at the entrance of the premises.</li> <li>➤ Only employees who have received a complete dose of vaccine and asymptomatic are allowed to work.</li> <li>➤ The owner of the business premises must ensure that the table layout according to the prison and the premises have a good ventilation system.</li> <li>➤ Dine-in activities with physical distancing of at least 1 meter are subject to SOP KPDNHEP VAT Phase 3 - Distribution Trade.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Individuals who have received a complete vaccination are allowed to bring children aged 18 and under to dine-in at the premises in accordance with general health protocols.</li> </ul>

Employee attendance is not more than 80% of the workforce covering management and operations. Consumption is among individuals who have COMPLETE VACCINATION for physical contact activities. Individuals who have received a complete vaccination are also allowed to bring children under the age of 18 to perform such activities in strict compliance with SOPs.</li> <li>All physical contact or non -contact sports and recreational activities performed individually or in groups in a CLOSED area (INDOOR) are RESTRICTED to individuals who have COMPLETED VACCINATION only starting at 6.00 am to 12.00 midnight subject to the movement control instructions in force.</li> <li>Operation of all sports and recreation facilities CLOSED (INDOOR) with compliance to 50% utilization capacity/ area WITH supervisory control. Employee attendance is not more than 80% of the workforce covering management and operations. Consumption is among individuals who have COMPLETE VACCINATION for physical contact activities. Individuals who have received a complete vaccination are also allowed to bring children under the age of 18 to perform such activities in strict compliance with SOPs.</li> </ul>






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10. Sports / Recreational Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Group contact or non-physical contact or non-contact sports and recreational activities or training conducted in a controlled manner WITH supervisory control are subject to 50% utilization capacity/ area or not exceeding 250 people at any one time including coaches/ instructors/ parents (any the lower). Individuals who have received a complete vaccination are also allowed to bring children under the age of 18 to perform such activities in strict compliance with SOPs.</li> <li>Organization of all tournaments or competitions with or without physical contact at the community/ district/ state/ national level WITH the permission of the Ministry of Youth and Sports (KBS) only.</li> <li>Organizing tournaments/ competitions/ mass sports events WITH the permission of KBS LIMITED to participation not exceeding 250 people at a time.</li> <li>Organizing international level tournaments or competitions according to the SPORTS BUBBLES model are subject to KBS PERMISSION only.</li> <li>Attendance of spectators/ supporters to sports and recreation venues is SUBJECT to 30% of area/ seating capacity or 10,000 people (whichever is lower) RESTRICTED for COMPLETELY VACCINATED individuals aged 18 years and above only.</li> <li>The operation of all public OPEN (OUTDOOR) and CLOSED (INDOOR) sports and recreational facilities is subject to the relevant Local Authority (PBT)/ Authority.</li> <li>Admission of foreign athletes/ coaches/ officers/ technicians to Malaysia is SUBJECT to compliance with the rules on the entry of foreigners into Malaysia.</li> <li><b>Adhere to the guidelines of the National COVID-19 Testing Strategy</b></li> </ul>
