REINFORCEMENT ACTIONS FOR PREVENTION AND CONTROL MEASURES CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) FOR TRAVELERS FROM OVERSEAS

As of December 6, 2021, a total of 43 countries have reported cases of COVID-19 infection with the new Omicron variant. Out of the 43 countries reported, eight (8) countries have been imposed temporary travel restrictions which started on November 27, 2021, and five (5) other countries have reported the transmission of the Omicron variant in their community. Those countries are as follows:

Accordingly, to prevent the entry and transmission of this variant into Malaysia, the Ministry of Health Malaysia (MOH) would like to inform that the reinforcement actions for preventive and control measures will be in place and will be available for travelers arriving in Malaysia according to the following categories:

- 1. Vaccinated Travel Lane (Air);
- 2. Vaccinated Travel Lane (Land);
- 3. Langkawi International Tourism Bubble (LITB);
- 4. One-Stop Center (OSC) for short-term business visitors;



- 5. Travelers from countries subject to temporary travel restrictions; and
- 6. Travelers from countries reported the spread of the new Omicron variant in the community.

For **travelers under categories 1 to 4**, a reinforcement action to the preventive and control measures are as follows:

- Travelers must have been **fully vaccinated**
- COVID-19 PCR test was performed within 2 days before departure to Malaysia, replacing the previous procedure which was prescribed 72 hours before departure.
- COVID-19 detection test upon arrival in Malaysia.
- RTK-Ag test or rapid antigen test (self) on 2nd day, 4th, and 6th after arrival.
- RTK-Ag test or rapid antigen test (professional) on the 3rd day and 5th after arrival.

All test results must be reported through the MySejahtera application.

For travelers under **categories 5 and 6**, the reinforcement action to the prevention and control measures are as follows:

- (a) Countries subject to temporary travel restrictions (Citizens and long-term visit pass holders):
- COVID-19 PCR test must be performed within 2 days before departing for Malaysia.
- Wearing digital tracking devices during the quarantine period is mandatory.
- Mandatory quarantine for 14 days at quarantine stations regardless of vaccination status.
- Quarantine and testing procedures upon arrival and throughout the quarantine period shall follow the current/existing procedures.
- (b) Countries reported the spread of Omicron variant in communities (Citizens and non-citizens):
- COVID-19 PCR test must be performed within 2 days before departing for Malaysia.
- Wearing digital tracking devices during the quarantine period is mandatory.
- The quarantine period depends on the vaccination status.
- To adhere to the existing procedures previously announced.



Detailed information regarding the type and frequency of tests to be performed by travelers entering Malaysia as well as other conditions that are set, is explained in **Appendix 1**. **These requirements will be effective on December 8, 2021.** These reinforcement actions will be reviewed from time to time.

- No need to undergo mandatory quarantine
- The period of stay in Malaysia is limited to the number of days approved by the OSC Committee and not exceeding 14 days
- Need to follow a controlled itinerary that has been approved by the OSC Committee
- Must be accompanied by a liaison officer (LO) provided by MIDA
- Additional tests as follows:
- Undergo rapid antigen testing (professional) on the 3rd and 5th day
- Undergo rapid antigen testing (self) on days 2, 4, and 6.
- Responsible for reporting test results through the MySejahtera application and LO to ensure all procedures are implemented.
