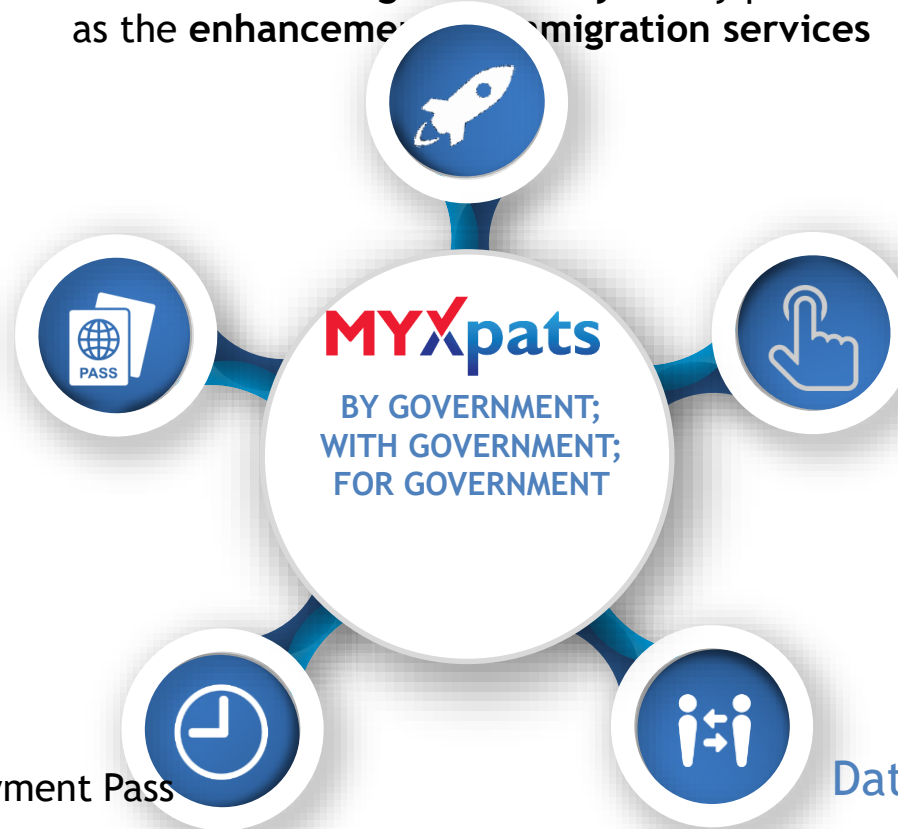

■ Introduction:

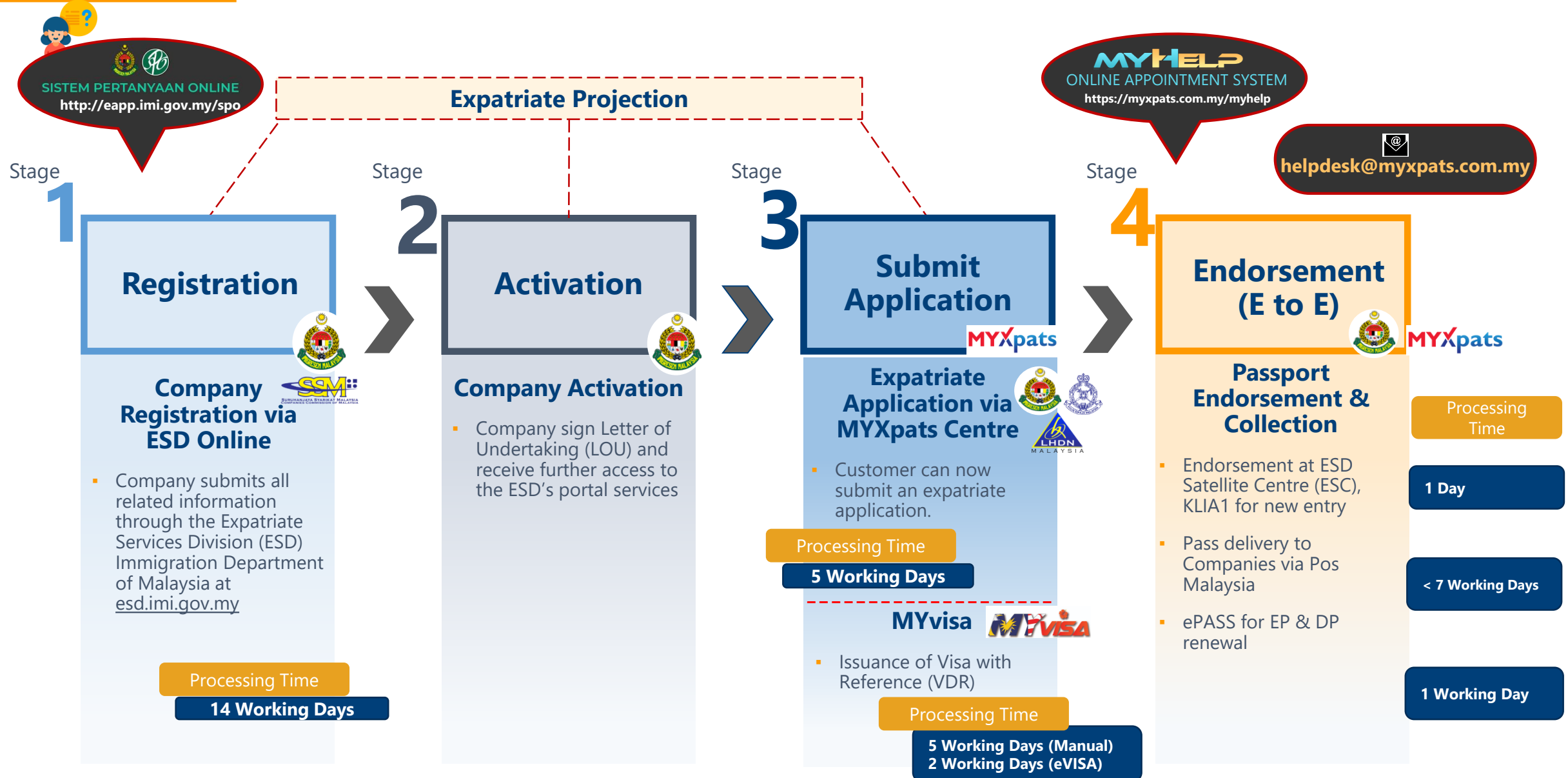
- A Professional Visit Pass (PVP) is granted to foreign talents with acceptable professional qualifications or skills.
- The position is **non-salaried**.
- The PVP is valid for up to 12 months only, it is non-renewable, and a new application will need to be made




The ePASS issuance is for **RENEWAL** application with a previous active pass that was endorsed in the same passport

Renewal with a new passport (without a previous pass endorsement) is **not applicable** for ePASS and therefore will be issued with a physical Pass.

The applicant must be physically in **Malaysia** during the endorsement stage
