

## **PROFESSIONAL VISIT PASS**



#### Introduction:

- A Professional Visit Pass (PVP) is granted to foreign talents with acceptable professional qualifications or skills.
- The position is **non-salaried**.
- The PVP is valid for up to 12 months only, it is non-renewable, and a new application will need to be made

#### Professional Visit Pass Categories:

Category I	Expertise Transfer	E.g: Installation & Fixing of Machines and Equipment Expert; Technical Advisor
Category II	Research	E.g: Researcher, Research Assistant
Category III	Training at ESD-registered companies	E.g: Professor; Lecturer; Speaker
Category IV	Volunteers	
Category V	Exhibitors under regulation of Malaysia Convention & Exhibition Bureau (MyCEB)	
Category VI	Student Internship under : Foreign Embassies ESD-registered companies Hotels	






