
Visitors to the MDBC Village can register to chat directly with representatives (of exhibitors) or to 'drop a name card'.

The auditorium not only providers visitors with a chance to view previous webinars, it also allows them to view any events






that happen to be livestreaming at that moment. As an exclusive offer to MDBC members, they are invited to make use of the auditorium and livestream their own




MDBC achieved an Overall Satisfaction Score of 74.8 %; slightly below our target of 80.0%.


MDBC achieved an Overall Satisfaction Score of 80.1%; meeting our Target Score of 80.0% and is the average of seven sections.
