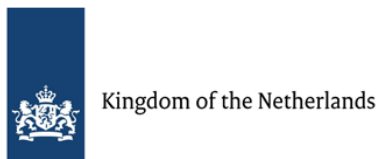

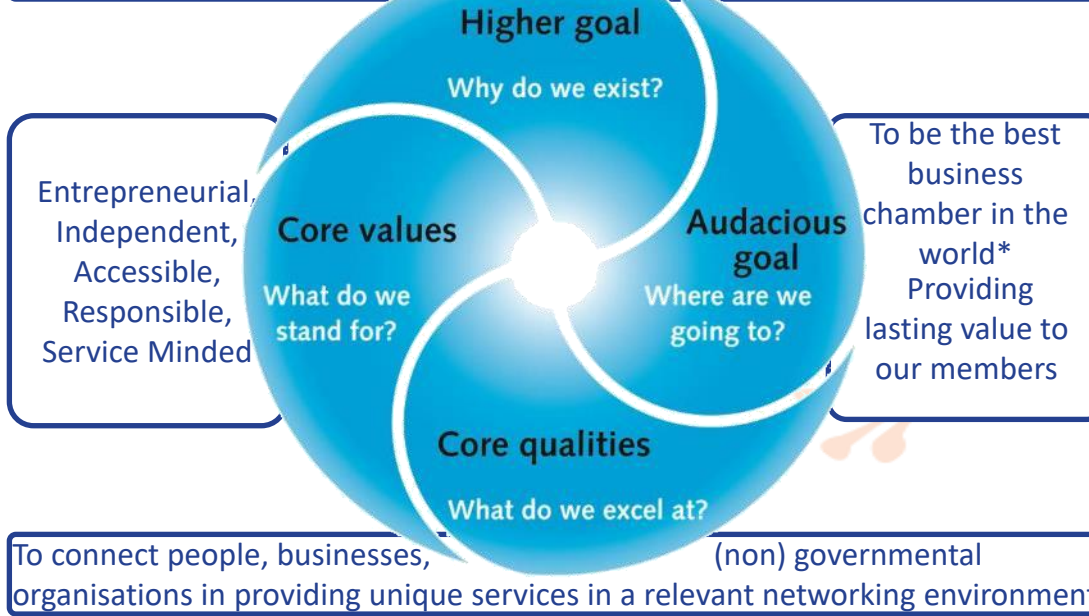

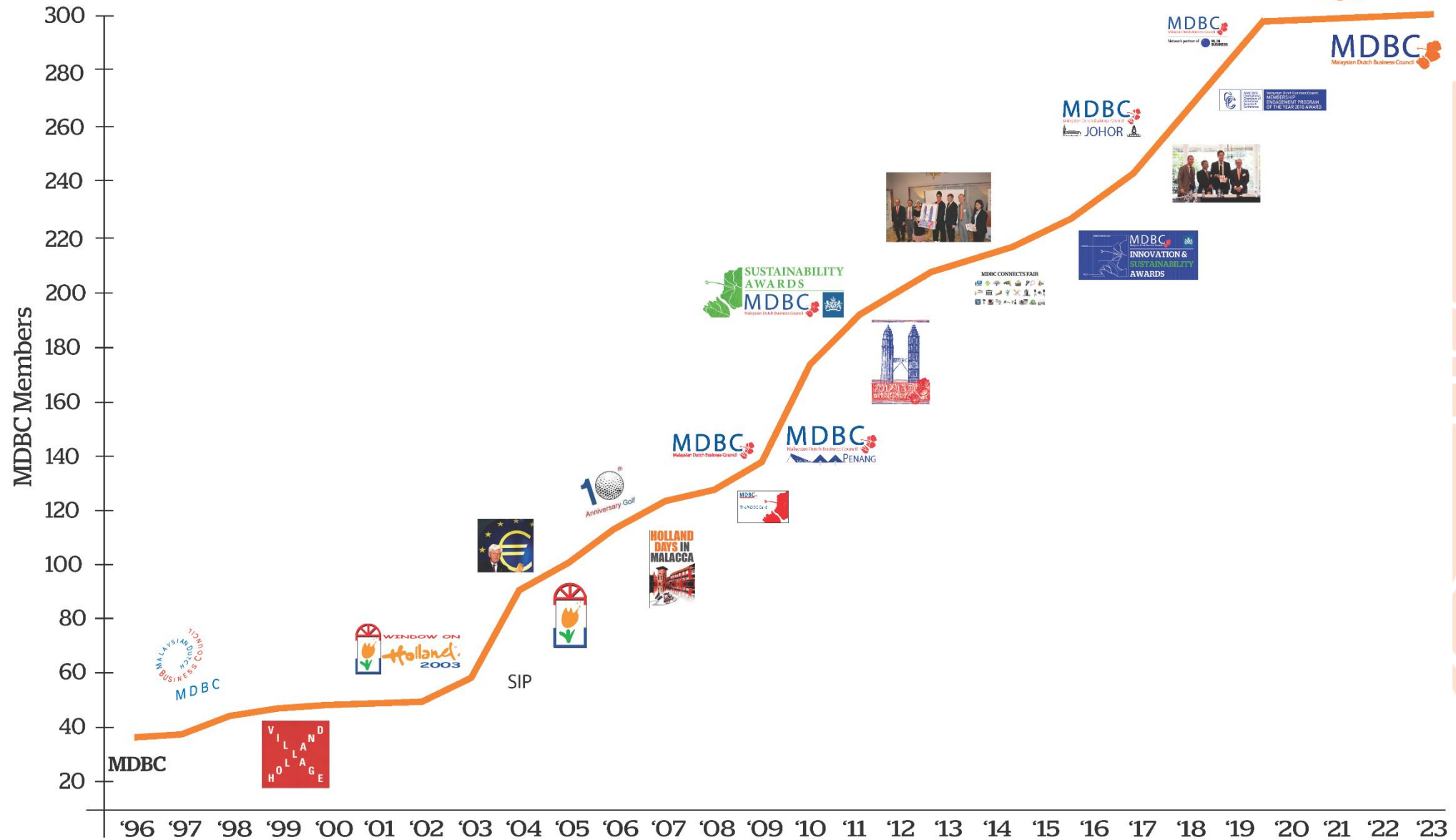
Strategy 2019 - 2025: defining audacious goal

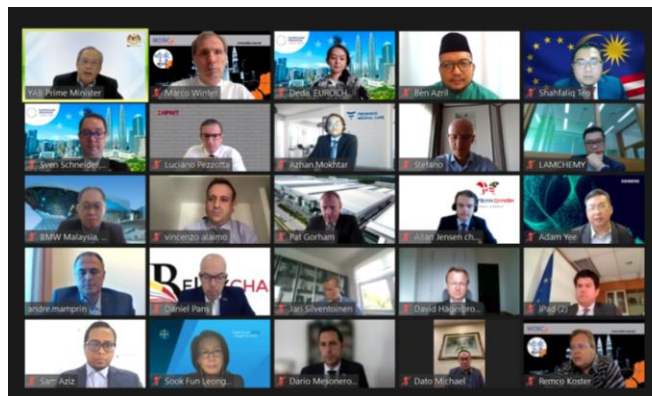

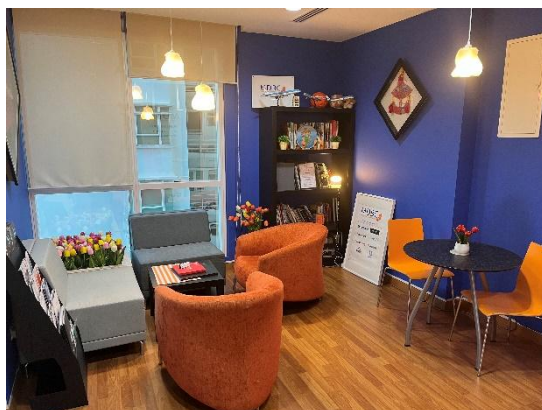

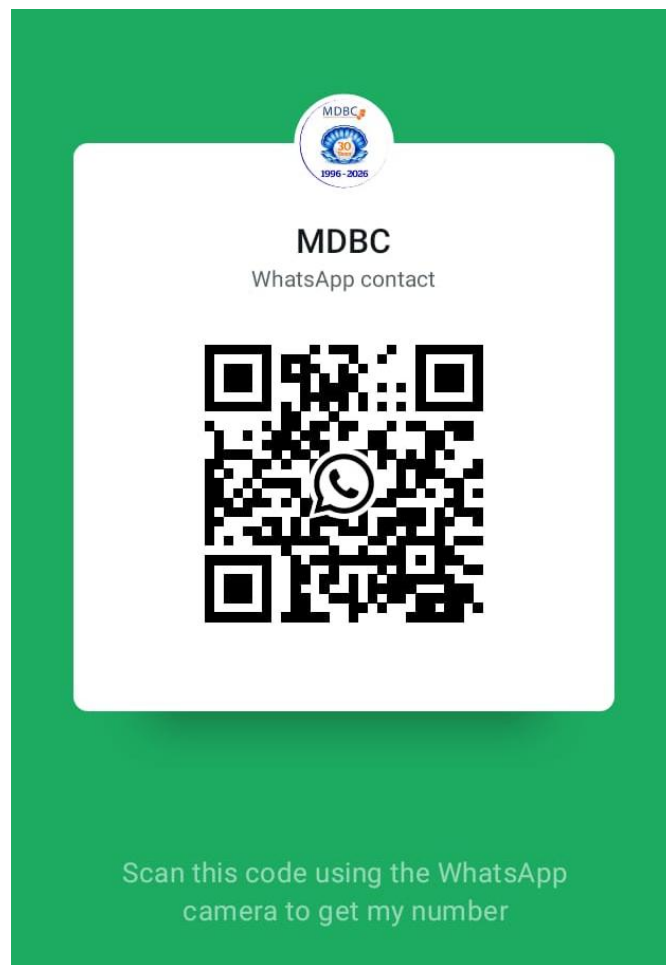
